CODE OF CONDUCT: The purpose of the South Windsor Code of Conduct, to be followed by every participant, is to emphasize good sportsmanship, proper conduct, and full compliance with the rules and polices. The South Windsor Code of Conduct applies to all players, officials, and spectators and is based on the following principles of sportsmanship:

1. Know the rules and abide by them.
2. Be generous when you lose.
3. Be gracious when you win.
4. The Recreation Department will not tolerate negative remarks or gesture to the opposing team or to the officials.
5. It is expected that the players will do their best at all times to avoid negative remarks to any player, official or captain, and act in a sportsmanlike manner always, win or lose.
6. It is expected that the players will play and not officiate the game.
7. All participants and spectators shall treat one another and all other people with dignity and respect.
8. Follow all building rules and regulations, respecting at all times the property of the town.
